

SNYDER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
2020 ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING
January 6, 2020

The meeting was called to order by temporary chairman Tom Sedlock in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 P.M. Supervisor Sedlock welcomed everyone present and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Michael Holt opened the nominations for Vice-Chairman of the Board of Supervisors: Michael Holt nominated Tom Sedlock for Vice-Chairman of the Board of Supervisors with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes. Motion carried. Michael Holt closed the nominations for Vice-Chairman of the Board of Supervisors.

Michael Holt motioned to retain Mary Fremer as Secretary-Treasurer with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes. Motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to retain Terry Fustine as EMA Director with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes. Motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to retain Attorney Ross Ferraro as Township Solicitor with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes. Motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to retain the group of Hess & Fisher, Inc. as Township Engineers with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes. Motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to retain Joe Puhala as Roadmaster with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes. Motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to retain Emerson Turnbull as Health and Code Officer with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes. Motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to retain Steve Varischetti as Vacancy Board with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes. Motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to retain Pennsafe as building code officer and Dave Tinker as the township SEO Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes. Motion carried.

RE-AFFIRMATION OF EMPLOYEES:

Michael Holt motioned to continue as is all township employee wages, holidays, vacations and benefits along with the IRS mileage amount of \$.57.5 for any township employee travel expenses with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes. Motion carried.

TOWNSHIP DEPOSITORIES:

Michael Holt motioned to continue to use S&T Bank as depository for the General Fund checking and First Commonwealth as depository for the Liquid Fuel Fund checking and continuing the two PLGIT Prime accounts with Tom Sedlock giving the second. All supervisors voted yes. Motion carried.

BUSINESS AND CITIZENS TO BE HEARD:

Terry Fustine stated he would be updating our EMA Plan. He reported on the fuel Spill at a Steeltown residence.

Jim Grant let the Board know the Auditors would be holding their organizational Immediately following the meeting this evening.

Emerson Turnbull added his report of the fuel spill incident.
