

Snyder Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
May 28, 2020

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone present, held a moment of silence for fallen Veterans, and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Tom Sedlock and Ronald Freemer. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, EMA Director Terry Fustine and Fire Chief Mike Hoskavich.

Correspondence included a notice of a minor permit application for National Fuel from Mott Macdonald. Maps were reviewed with a motion to accept from Mike Holt and second from Ron Freemer. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

The minutes from the April meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of May 30, 2020. General Funds balance \$486,604.44; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$265,920.90. Ron Freemer motioned to accept the treasurer's report with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

Robert Ishman was present to observe a township meeting in preparation to apply for the Snyder Township and Jefferson County scholarships.

Jason and Ed Serafini were present to voice their desire for opening township roads to ATV travel. They were told this is being considered.

Township Reports

The Code Officer was not present but he has been watching a situation for any violations.

EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine reported on the activities for the Township EMA for the month of May looking to our area going to the green phase of the quarantine.

The Fire Company Chief reported on the activities of the Brockway Fire Company for the month of May and the adjustments to their activities and trainings with the covid-19 restrictions.

The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of May.

The Solicitor was not present.

Michael Holt motioned to purchase the accessories for the ordered new truck from Walsh Equipment with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to hire Gary Delp as part-time road crew with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried. He also added Ron Holt, presently on our part-time crew would continue as needed.

New Business

Ron Freemer motioned to accept the Third-Party Installation Agreement with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

Frank Colletti presented the supervisors with the plans for the renovation of the meeting room/office. Michael Holt motioned to advertise the renovation project for bids with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

Michael Holt let the meeting know ATV travel on township roads is being researched by our solicitor along with the procedure we must follow to bid the renovation project.
