

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors**  
**Regular Monthly Meeting**  
**June 25, 2020**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Tom Sedlock and Ronald Freemer. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, EMA Director Terry Fustine, Auditor Jake Rindosh and Fire Chief Mike Hoskavich.

There was no correspondence.

The minutes from the May meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of June 27, 2020. General Funds balance \$499,175.73; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$260,671.31. Mary added that the General Fund compared to last year at the halfway point in the year has our income down \$2000.00 with the expense also down \$28,000.00. Ron Freemer motioned to accept the treasurer's report with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

**Public Participation**

Jake Rindosh let the road crew know the good job they did on the repair on Seventh Avenue Extension.

**Township Reports**

The Code Officer was not present.

EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine reported on the activities for the Township EMA for the month of June. Mike Holt motioned for him to purchase a base radio for the office with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried. He also added all weather alert systems will be tested the first Monday of each month right after the fire alarm system testing.

The Fire Company Chief reported on the activities of the Brockway Fire Company for the month of June.

The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of June. The supervisors will look into a raise for the road crew at the next meeting July 30<sup>th</sup>.

The Solicitor was not present.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Ron Freemer motioned to approve the additional road bond for Otis Eastern Services LLC bonding for National Fuel with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

Ron Freemer motioned to approve the road bond for T. English Construction LLC on Seventh Avenue Extension with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

Results of renovation bids which had been opened earlier in the meeting was a bid from Keith Brothers for the heating, ventilation and air for \$14,591.64. No other bids were received.

The board stated they were still researching ATV travel on township roads having received information from their Solicitor.

Michael Holt motioned to finance at 3.12% for 4 years for the full price of the Freightliner Truck with S&T Bank and purchase the additional attachments using our Liquid Fuels Account with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.
