

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors**  
**Regular Monthly Meeting**  
**July 30, 2020**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Tom Sedlock and Ronald Freemer. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, EMA Director Terry Fustine, Auditor Jake Rindosh and Fire Chief Mike Hoskavich. Resident present was Lydia Holt.

Correspondence included a letter from Jefferson County Conservation District approving the minor amendment for the National Fuel Brockway Modernization Project, a notice from County EMA announcing the monthly weather siren testing and a notice from County Solid Waste of their September recycling days.

The minutes from the June meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of August 1, 2020. General Funds balance \$494,373.98; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$256,380.71. Added to the report was the breakdown of our Act 13 Revenues with that having a \$108,556.12 balance.

Lydia Holt was present for the meeting to present her application for the Township Scholarship.

**Township Reports**

The Code Officer was not present. Emerson will be contacted as to a burning complaint for a residence on Game School Road.

EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine reported on the activities for the Township EMA for the month of July with the recent flooding emergency at Clay Plant Road.

The Fire Company Chief reported on the activities of the Brockway Fire Company for the month of July. The company has received two grants and they will proceed with the burning training at the Sugar Hill house on September 12<sup>th</sup>. The gun bash was held successfully but with some loss.

The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of July. Mike Holt motioned to hold Fall Clean-up Days September 11 and 12, 2020 from 7AM to 5 PM each day with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

The Solicitor was not present.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Ron Freemer motioned to give all hourly road crew members a \$.25 per hour raise beginning August 1, 2020 with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

Mike Holt motioned to complete the culvert pipe project at Fermantown Road with 15" pipe and any needed catch basins from Route 219 to the Soccer Field Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

The ATV issue was tabled for further consideration.

Mike Holt motioned to accept the bid from Keith Brothers, Inc. of \$14,591.64 for the heating, ventilation and air conditioning for the meeting room renovation project with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Ron Freemer motioned to donate 20 ton of 2B limestone to the Brockway Historical Society for their project at the Pioneer Cemetery with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

Mike Holt motioned to grant Ray Calhoun his request for storm water exemption with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

Tom Sedlock mentioned the \$500,000.00 Rattlesnake Creek Clean-up project.

Terry Fustine added all the local volunteer organizations helping with the flood issue with a residence on Clay Plant Road.
