

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
August 27, 2020**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Tom Sedlock and Ronald Freemer. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, EMA Director Terry Fustine, Auditor Jim Grant and Fire Chief Mike Hoskavich. A resident present was Jason Serafini.

Correspondence included a letter from Jefferson County EMA announcing a burn ban starting August 27, 2020 and continuing for the next 30 days.

Michael Holt motioned to extend a burn ban till end of September for Snyder Township with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes; motion carried.

The minutes from the July meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of August 29, 2020. General Funds balance \$518,965.23; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$212,636.64.

Public Participation

Jason Serafini was present to let the Board know of a junk problem in the Crenshaw area and also to ask if ATV travel on township roads had been decided yet. He was told it is still being researched.

Township Reports

The Code Officer was not present. Emerson will be contacted concerning the junk issue asking him to step up the violation to next level. He will also be advised the illegal burning has not ceased at the Game School Road residence.

EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine had nothing to report.

The Fire Company Chief reported on the activities of the Brockway Fire Company for the month of August.

The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of August.
