

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
September 24, 2020**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Thomas Sedlock and Ronald Freemer. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, EMA Director Terry Fustine, Auditor Jake Rindosh and Fire Chief Mike Hoskavich.

There was no correspondence.

The minutes from the August meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of September 26, 2020. General Funds balance \$513,532.46; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$188,770.15. Ronald Freemer motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report with Thomas Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes, motion carried.

Public Participation

Jake Rindosh asked if tax collection had been going well and was assured it was. He asked about the progress with improvements to Siple Road over the creek and was told it will continue when we get our permit.

Township Reports

The Code Officer was not present.

EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine reported on weather siren and fire alarm testing schedule.

The Fire Company Chief reported on the activities of the Brockway Fire Company for the month of September. The controlled burn was a success, Fire Prevention Week will be October 4-10, 2020 and mentioned their other fund raisers and activities

The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of September.

The Solicitor was not present.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Michael Holt motioned to obtain credit cards for the township with a credit limit of \$5,000.00 for Joe Puhala and \$2,500.00 limit for Mary Fremer with Ronald Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes, motion carried.

Ronald Freemer motioned to advertise the building office renovation for re-bid with Thomas Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes, motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to purchase a 2007 Elgin Pelican Street Sweeper for \$72,000.00; purchase price \$75,000.00 less \$3,000.00 trade-in with Ronald Freemer second. Michael Holt and Ronald Freemer voted yes, Thomas Sedlock voted no, motion carried.

Ronald Freemer motioned to approve the Landlord Agreement with the Jefferson County Commissioners to allow the November 3, 2020 election held at the Snyder Township Building with Thomas Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes, motion carried.

Supervisors feel the building is ready for the November election if the state decides to go that way.
