

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
April 29, 2021**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Ronald Freemer and Thomas Sedlock. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, EMA Director Terry Fustine, and Auditors Jake Rindosh and Jim Grant. Visitors present were Don Liedl and Jim Ross.

Correspondence included a letter informing the township of intention to drill a gas well in Winslow Township.

The minutes from the March meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of April 30, 2021. General Funds balance \$417,366.05; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$235,299.74. Ronald Freemer motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report with Thomas Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Township Reports

EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine let the board know he attended the zoom training, and then proceeded to report on the activities of the township EMA during the month of April. He also reported on the activities for the Fire Company with the fire chief's absence.

The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of April.

The Solicitor was not present.
