

Snyder Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
June 24, 2021

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Ronald Freemer and Thomas Sedlock. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, EMA Director Terry Fustine and Fire Company Chief Mike Hoskavich. Joe asked if grinding could be done on Seventh Avenue Extension and Baghdad Road. Cost needs to be figured and then supervisors will decide.
