

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors**  
**Regular Monthly Meeting**  
**April 28, 2022**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Ronald Freemer and Thomas Sedlock. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, Auditor Jake Rindosh, Code Office Jeff Knapp and EMA Director Terry Fustine. Visitors were Herbie Holt and Terry Maher.

Correspondence included a notification from County Solid Waste of their upcoming Hazardous Waste Collection Day, a letter from DEP letting the township know of Waroquier Coal permit revision and a letter from Brockway True Value announcing the store closing in Brockway.

The minutes from the March meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of April 30, 2022. ARPA Fund balance \$13,215.84; General Funds balance \$299,374.19; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$228,641.61. Michael Holt motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

**Public Participation**

Terry Maher was present to announce the Fourth of July Bicycle Race would be held after two years without this race. Michael Holt motioned to approve the use of the township roads on the bike route and to sign the PennDot approval with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Jake Rindosh pointed out road hazards at Seventh Avenue Extension and at Pine Acres Road. Joe will get these areas improved.

**Township Reports**

Code Officer Jeff Knapp reported on numerous violation areas. He is continuing to work along with the Health Code Officer to remedy situations. Both officers will be given copies of ordinances they need for their jobs. Michael Holt motioned to reimburse Jeff for his downloading the Onx Map App to his phone with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine reported on the activities of the EMA for the month of April. Weather sirens have been found and they will continue to research this and get two sirens up and running. Terry also reported on the activities for the fire department for the month of April.

The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of April.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Ron Freemer motioned to hire Yard Works for lawn care for 2022 with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Ron Freemer motioned to approve the township building as polling place for the May 17<sup>th</sup> primary election with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to vote for all nominees for election of Trustees for the PLIGIT Shareholders Meeting May 20, 2022 with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Ron Freemer motioned to approve the naming of a private drive off Kearney Road, Baker Acres Lane, with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

It was decided as far as the Rt 219 Storm Water Drainage Project was concerned supervisors want to help the land owners but will not subject the township to be responsible for the maintenance of the improvement. They continue to meet and will find a good agreement for this.

Michael Holt motioned to amend the agenda with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Michael Holt proposed the township helping fund a new digital sign, a project of the Brockway Kaimans Club. Ron Freemer motioned to budget \$22,000.00 of the ARPA Fund money for 2022 Tom Sedlock second. Ron Freemer and Tom Sedlock voted yes with Michael Holt abstaining because of conflict of interest and the motion carried.
