

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
May 26, 2022**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Ronald Freemer and Thomas Sedlock. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, Fire Company Rep Devin Trentini and EMA Director Terry Fustine. Visitors were Ernie Inzana.

Correspondence included an announcement by Jefferson County Township Officials Association of their two \$500.00 scholarships to be awarded In July 2022, and a letter from John Simchick of his pending retirement from his computer business.

The minutes from the April meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of May 28, 2022. ARPA Fund balance \$13,221.67; General Funds balance \$424,965.96; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$227,502.22. Ron Freemer motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Public Participation

Ernie Inzana questioned new regulations for water customers. Michael Holt answered his concerns.

Township Reports

Code Officer Jeff Knapp was not present but had sent his report as to his continuing investigations of various township violations.

EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine reported on the activities of the EMA for the month of May. A weather siren has been found and will be painted and a suitable location found for installation. Terry will let the board know a donation amount for the siren at the next meeting.

Fire Company Rep Devin Trentini reported on the activities for the Brockway Fire Company for the month of May.

The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of May. Michael Holt motioned to give all part time road crew employees a \$1.00 raise beginning May 31st with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

The Solicitor was not present.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Michael Holt motioned to advertise to hire a full-time road crew employee with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

It is now discovered the Route 219 Water Drainage Project is not something the township should need to be involved in. The information will be sent to those who need to pursue this further.

NEW BUSINESS:

For the 2022 \$500.00 Scholarship, applications will be received till August 22nd with the opening for meeting August 25th.

Ron Freemer motioned to table the request for a donation from Jefferson County History Center till we receive the ARPA funds for 2022 with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to terminate the main account in our pension plan with NGL Insurance Company and spread the balance in that account equally among the active members of the plan approving Resolution 2022-4 with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.
