

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors**  
**Regular Monthly Meeting**  
**June 30, 2022**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Ronald Freemer and Thomas Sedlock. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, Fire Company Chief Mike Hoskavich, Code Officer Jeff Knapp and EMA Director Terry Fustine. Visitors were Dennis Smith, Sharon Fustine, Jim Crawford, Morgan Carnahan and James Burkholder.

There was no correspondence.

The minutes from the May meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of July 2, 2022. ARPA Fund balance \$13,230.50; General Funds balance \$411,166.96; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$201,760.24. Michael Holt motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

**Public Participation**

Dennis Smith questioned his not receiving any unemployment compensation as yet. This will be looked into.

Jim Crawford had concerns for Walburn Run Road hauling and was told the activity is on state and private drives.

Morgan Carnahan let the board know she was observing the meeting as part of her requirements for the township scholarship.

James Burkholder was present to follow up on his driveway permits.

**Township Reports**

Code Officer Jeff Knapp was present and reported on his continuing investigations of various township violations.

EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine reported on the activities of the EMA for the month of June. Falls Creek Firemen have requested \$300.00 for the weather siren. Michael Holt motioned to pay the \$300.00 for the siren to the Falls Creek Fire Company with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Fire Company Chief Mike Hoskavich reported on the activities for the Brockway Fire Company for the month of June. They continue with classes, trainings and fund raisers. They have also recently agreed on the purchase of a truck with their old one going out for sale.

The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of June.

The Solicitor was not present.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

The applications have been received for hiring a road crew full time employee and interviews will be held.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Michael Holt motioned to donate \$15,000.00 to the Brockway Recreation Board from our ARPA Funds. The motion died for lack of a second.

Michael Holt motioned to approve the road bond for Big Buck Lumber with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to comply with the current IRS mileage of 62.5 per mile for township employees with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to approve the driveway permits for James Burkholder at 20 Livingood Lane and Ned Hauptner for Lot 74 at Glasshurst with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

The secretary asked to approve her hours to be 1-5PM for office hours for the week of July 18th – to the 22<sup>nd</sup>. Supervisors approved.
