

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
July 28, 2022**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Ronald Freemer and Thomas Sedlock. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, Fire Company Chief Mike Hoskavich, Code Officer Jeff Knapp, Health Code Officer Jennifer Challingsworth and EMA Director Terry Fustine. A visitor was James Burkholder.

Supervisors went into an executive session with their solicitor to discuss a meeting matter. Returning the meeting was called back to order.

Correspondence included a notice from county solid waste of their August 27th hazardous waste collection.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of July 31, 2022. ARPA Fund balance \$13,639.81; General Funds balance \$408,720.06; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$169,708.11. The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of July. Michael Holt motioned to schedule Fall Clean-up Days September 9th and 10th with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried. He was also advised to have A&R Tree Service to daylight numerous areas and chip up the remains of the 219 trees PennDot will be removing while they are here.

The Solicitor updated the Board on the repairs to Fermantown Road with Otis Eastern Services, LLC and the possible future abandonment of a township right-of-way.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Michael Holt motioned to hire David S. McDowell fulltime beginning August 1, 2022 at \$16.00 per hour for the road crew with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:
