

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors  
Regular Monthly Meeting  
August 25, 2022**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Ronald Freemer and Thomas Sedlock. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, Fire Company Chief Mike Hoskavich, Code Officer Jeff Knapp and EMA Director Terry Fustine. A visitor was Jim Ross.

There was no correspondence.

The minutes from the July meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of August 27, 2022. ARPA Fund balance \$13,658.02; General Funds balance \$414,661.83; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$139,585.35. Ron Freemer motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

**Township Reports**

Code Officer Jeff Knapp was present and reported on his continuing activities and investigations of various township inspections and violations. Many have been resolved and supervisors complimented him.

EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine reported on the activities of the EMA for the month of August. The continuing job to get the new siren up and ready is being finalized.

Fire Company Chief Mike Hoskavich reported on the activities for the Brockway Fire Company for the month of August. Grants, donations, trainings and fund raisers were reported.

The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of August. Road oil applications have been completed.

The Solicitor was not present but had sent the Board updates on the repairs to Fermantown Road with Otis Eastern Services, LLC and right of way abandonment at Livingood Lane.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Michael Holt motioned to bill James Burkholder the \$500.00 attorney fees paid by the township for the Livingood Lane project with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Ron Freemer motioned to approve the \$15,000.00 donation request from the Brockway Recreation Board with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried. This was requested per our receipt of the 2022 ARPA Fund allocation.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Michael Holt motioned to approve the road bond for Big Buck Lumber with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

As the only student applying, the annual Snyder Township Scholarship of \$500.00 was awarded to Morgan Carnahan.

Terry Fustine asked that vests be considered for township officers when on the job or in an emergency situation. Options will be researched.
