

Snyder Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
September 29, 2022

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. A moment of silence was held to acknowledge the passing of long time auditor, James Grant.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Ronald Freemer and Thomas Sedlock. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, Fire Company Chief Mike Hoskavich, Code Officer Jeff Knapp, EMA Director Terry Fustine and Auditor Jake Rindosh.

There was no correspondence.

The minutes from the August meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of September 30, 2022. ARPA Fund balance \$124,684.69; General Funds balance \$409,197.78; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$223,661.11. Ron Freemer motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Public Participation

Jake Rindosh also serving as Township Recreation Board Rep thanked the board for the recent donation and gave an update of the activities of the Rec Board.

Township Reports

Code Officer Jeff Knapp was present and reported on his continuing activities and investigations of various township inspections and violations.

EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine reported on the activities of the EMA for the month of September. Getting the new siren up is progressing along with possible improvements to the existing siren here at the building.

Fire Company Chief Mike Hoskavich reported on the activities for the Brockway Fire Company for the month of September. A large donation commitment has been promised towards the new truck and grants, donations, trainings and fund raisers are continuing. They will be holding Fire Prevention Week and helping with Halloween festivities.

The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of September. Road daylighting has been done well also. Joe gave code officer Knapp a complaint to investigate.

The Solicitor was not present but had sent the Board the final offer from Otis LLC for the repairs to Fermantown Road.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Michael Holt motioned to approve the request for \$15,000.00 from the Brockway Sewage Association from our ARPA Fund with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Michael Holt motioned to accept the final settlement of \$60,000.00 for the Fermantown Road damages with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried

NEW BUSINESS:

Michael Holt motioned to approve voting November 8, 2022 here at the township building with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

The opening of township roads to ATV and snowmobile travel was tabled. Representative Brian Smith will be asked to attend the October meeting to expand on this.

Replacing Auditor James Grant was discussed along with the vests for township officials and EMA. The tree along 219 south will be removed on November 2nd by PennDot.
