

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
October 27, 2022**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Ronald Freemer and Thomas Sedlock. The minutes from the September meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of October 29, 2022. ARPA Fund balance \$87,862.50; General Funds balance \$459,249.63; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$68,340.80. Ron Freemer motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.
