

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
December 29, 2022**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Ronald Freemer and Thomas Sedlock. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, EMA Director Terry Fustine, Auditor Jake Rindosh, Fire Chief Mike Hoskavich and Code Officer Jeff Knapp. Visitor present was Sharon Fustine.

Correspondence included a letter from Country Kids Nature Preschool with their 22-23 emergency plan to be filed and a termination approval letter for the Brockway Modernization Project with National Fuel from county conservation.

The minutes from the November meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of December 31, 2022. ARPA Fund balance \$88,383.66; General Funds balance \$414,865.26; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$55,391.02. Ron Freemer motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Public Participation

Jake Rindosh asked about the action with the ATV travel on township roads and was told this will happen in 2023 with a public meeting held first and then the board would vote on it.

Township Reports

Code Officer Jeff Knapp reported his activities for the two properties in question are continuing with working along with solicitor Ferarro.

EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine reported on the activities of the EMA for the month of December. The sirens are moving forward with installation.

Mike Hoskavich gave a report on the activities for the Brockway Fire Company for the month of December which included grants, fund raisers and trainings.

The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of December.

The Solicitor was not present.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Michael Holt motioned to adopt 2023 Budget with no tax increase with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Michael Holt motioned to approve the transfer of \$47,500.00 from the ARPA Fund to the General Fund to cover the Volunteer Firemen donation of \$45,000.00 and the donation to the Brookville Trail Hub of \$2,500.00 with Ron Freemer second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Ron Freemer motioned to adopt Resolution 2022-5 a resolution to implement Act 57 with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

FOR THE GOOD OF THE ORDER

The supervisors decided to change the Organizational Meeting to Thursday January 5, 2023 at 7 PM. Jake Rindosh stated the auditors would also change their meeting to immediately following that same evening.

Terry Fustine stated he is applying for funds to help with the siren project.

Ronald Freemer motioned to adjourn at 7:40 P.M. with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.
