

Snyder Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
January 26, 2023

The monthly meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Ronald Freemer in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Vice-Chairman Freemer welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Ronald Freemer and Thomas Sedlock. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Mary Fremer, Roadmaster Joe Puhala, EMA Director Terry Fustine, Auditor Jake Rindosh, Fire Chief Mike Hoskavich, Tax Collector Lisa Grecco and Code Officer Jeff Knapp. Visitors present were Bruce Miller, Shelley Miller and Fran Foradori.

Correspondence was a letter from OI announcing a permit modification permit application.

The minutes from the December meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read with balances as of January 28, 2023. ARPA Fund balance \$41,207.63; General Funds balance \$452,554.96; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$48,720.78. Ron Freemer motioned to acknowledge receiving the Treasurer's Report with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Public Participation

Jake Rindosh asked about a township truck being towed and was told what had happened.

Bruce Miller, Shelley Miller, Fran Foradori and Lisa Grecco voiced their concerns about the ATV travel on township roads. Tom Sedlock made remarks concerning his feeling on this subject and they were reminded a public meeting will be scheduled to address this. Bruce Miller also mentioned an extreme noise problem in neighboring townships and his concern our township needs to get something in place to deal with this if it would ever arise.

Township Reports

Code Officer Jeff Knapp reported his activities for the two properties in question. One property at 219 North has been condemned with the other at Arch St. has him continuing to working with Solicitor Ferarro.

EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine reported on the activities of the EMA for the month of January. The location for the new siren is still being researched to find a place for it to be installed. An additional siren has been found and Ron Freemer motioned to purchase this for \$300.00 taken from the ARPA Fund with Tom Sedlock second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried. Terry let the board know he and Jeff Knapp would attend the meeting to Complete the Mitigation Documents.

Mike Hoskavich gave a report on the activities for the Brockway Fire Company for the month of January which included grants, fund raisers and trainings.

The Roadmaster reported on the road work and equipment maintenance for the month of January.

The Solicitor was not present.
